By Mr. Woodward of Walpole, petition of Francis H. Woodward (by vote of the town) relative to the use of the Oak Grove Farmhouse in the town of Millis. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF THE OAK GROVE FARMHOUSE IN THE TOWN OF MILLIS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight D
2 of chapter forty of the General Laws or any other general or
3 special law to the contrary, the historical commission of the town
4 of Millis is hereby authorized to allow the Oak Grove Farmhouse
5 to be used as the Millis scout house and to allow said farmhouse
6 to be enlarged to provide toilet facilities and to allow said
7 farmhouse to be used for recreational functions and equipment
8 storage.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
