AN ACT TO FURTHER EXEMPT WAGES FROM ATTACHMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 28 of chapter 246 of the General Laws, as  
2 more recently amended by chapter 264 of the acts of  
3 1947, is hereby further amended by striking out in line  
4 3 the words "twenty-five dollars" and inserting the  
5 words: — forty dollars.
