

Bill accompanying the petition of A. A. Porter for legislation to provide for the safety of persons engaged in the care of buildings. Mercantile Affairs. January 22.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seven.

AN ACT

To secure the Safety of Persons engaged in cleaning Windows of Buildings in the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. No owner of any building in the city of
2 Boston three or more stories in height shall allow the
3 washing or cleaning of the windows of said building
4 above the second story by any employee standing or
5 being upon the outside of such buildings.

1 SECTION 2. The building commissioner of said city
2 shall have the general oversight and supervision of the
3 requirements of this act and so far as possible prescribe
4 some uniform method for doing said work so as to
5 insure the safety of all employees engaged therein.

1 SECTION 3. The owner of any building violating the
2 provisions of this act shall be subject to a fine not exceed-
3 ing one hundred dollars.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
