RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE ADVISABILITY AND FEASIBILITY OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SKATING RINK AT LAKE COCHITUATE STATE PARK BY THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of
2 three members of the senate to be designated by the president
3 thereof, one of whom shall be the senator from the Middlesex
4 and Worcester district; five members of the house of representa-
5 tives to be designated by the speaker thereof, one of whom shall
6 be the representative from the sixth Middlesex district, two of
7 whom shall be the representatives from the eighth Middlesex
8 district and one of whom shall be the representative from the
9 tenth Middlesex district; the commissioner of natural resources
10 or his designee; and two persons to be appointed by the gov-
11 ernor; is hereby established for the purpose of making an investi-
12 gation and study of the advisability and feasibility of the con-
13 struction of a skating rink at Lake Cochituate state park by the
14 department of natural resources.

15 Said commission shall be provided with quarters in the state
16 house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may travel within and
17 without the commonwealth and may expend for clerical and
18 other assistance and expenses such sums as may be appropriated
19 therefor. Said commission shall report to the general court the
20 results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations,
21 if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its
22 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk
23 of the house of representatives on or before the fourth Wednesday
24 of December in the current year.
