AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING REPORTING REQUIREMENTS OF CONSTABLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 91B of chapter 41 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1994 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end
3 thereof the following paragraph:—

4 Upon his qualification, the appointing authority shall send a
5 written notice thereof, giving the name and residence of the
6 appointee, and the telephone number of his office, the amount of
7 the bond, the name of the city or town in which the constable will
8 serve, the date of appointment, term and the expiration date
9 thereof to the state secretary. A list of such constables, so
10 appointed, shall be recorded in a book kept for that purpose and
11 shall be available to the public at all reasonable times.
