AN ACT RELATIVE TO PAYMENTS FOR CERTAIN EAR INJURIES UNDER THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 36 of chapter 152 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out paragraphs (f) and (g), as most re-
3 cently amended by section 1 of chapter 471 of the acts of 1962,
4 and inserting in place thereof the following paragraphs:—

5 (f) For the loss or substantial loss of hearing of both ears,
6 four hundred weeks.

7 (g) For the loss or substantial loss of hearing of one ear, one
8 hundred and fifty weeks.
