## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighteen.

### AN ACT

Relating to Sittings of the Supreme Judicial and Superior Courts in the County of Bristol.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The third paragraph of section  
2 twenty-four of chapter one hundred and fifty-  
3 seven of the Revised Laws is hereby amended by  
4 striking out the words "Fall River", in the fifth  
5 line, and substituting the words:—New Bed-  
6 ford,—so that said paragraph shall read as  
7 follows:—For the county of Bristol, for civil  
8 business, at Taunton, on the first Monday of  
9 March and the second Monday of September,  
10 and at New Bedford, on the first Mondays of  
11 May and December; for criminal business, at

12 Taunton, on the first Monday of February, at  
13 New Bedford, on the first Monday of June, and  
14 at New Bedford, on the first Monday of No-  
15 vember.

1 SECTION 2. The fourth paragraph of section  
2 twenty-one of chapter one hundred and fifty-six  
3 of the Revised Laws is hereby amended by strik-  
4 ing out the words "New Bedford", in the second  
5 line, and substituting the word:— Taunton,—  
6 so that said paragraph shall read as follows:—  
7 For the counties of Bristol, Dukes County and  
8 Nantucket, at Taunton, on the third Tuesday  
9 of April, and at Taunton, on the second Tuesday  
10 of November.
