Said rates of wages shall be requested of the commissioner by the commonwealth or by a county, city, town or district, and shall be furnished by the commissioner in a schedule containing the classifications of jobs and the rate of wages to be paid for each job. Said rates of wages shall include payments to health and welfare plans, or, if no such plan is in effect between employers and employees, the amount of such payments shall be paid directly to said employees.

**Chap. 538.** AN ACT INCREASING THE FEE FOR EXAMINATIONS FOR A LICENSE IN VETERINARY MEDICINE.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The second sentence of the first paragraph of section 55 of chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 6 of chapter 347 of the acts of 1967, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 16, the word "twenty-five" and inserting in place thereof the word: — fifty.

SECTION 2. The third sentence of said first paragraph of said section 55 of said chapter 112, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 13, the word "twenty-five" and inserting in place thereof the word: — fifty.

SECTION 3. The fifth sentence of said first paragraph of said section 55 of said chapter 112, as appearing in chapter 46 of the acts of 1965, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 3, the word "twenty-five" and inserting in place thereof the word: — fifty.

**Chap. 539.** AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY TO SELL AND CONVEY CERTAIN PARCELS OF LAND FOR RELOCATION PURPOSES TO CERTAIN DISPLACED BUSINESS CONCERNS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (b) of section five of chapter one hundred and sixty-one A of the General Laws or any other provision of general or special law, the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority, hereinafter called the Authority, is authorized: — To sell and convey to any business concern which has become a displaced occupant, as defined in section one of chapter seventy-nine A of the General Laws, by eminent domain proceedings by the authority, for relocation purposes at fair market value, any land or interest therein which said authority determines is not needed for its purposes.
