AN ACT

To amend Chapter one Hundred and Ninety-nine of the Acts of the Year Eighteen Hundred and Seventy-seven, relating to the Settlement of Probate Accounts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1 SECT. 1. Section three of chapter one hundred
2 and ninety-nine of the acts of the year eighteen
3 hundred and seventy-seven is hereby amended by
4 inserting after the word "guardian," in the second
5 line thereof, the following words: "after the ap-
6 pointment of a guardian *ad litem*, or next friend, as
7 provided in section one," and by striking out of said
8 section the words "who are of lawful age and le-
9 gally competent, and have had actual notice of the
10 same."

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
