**AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EXTENSION OF RUNWAYS AT THE GENERAL
EDWARD LAWRENCE LOGAN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 No runway which on January first, nineteen hundred and
- 2 sixty-five was in existence at the General Edward Lawrence
- 3 Logan International Airport shall be extended in the direction
- 4 of East Boston.

It is the duty of the Senate to advise and consent to the appointment and removal of officers of the Executive branch of the Government.

The Constitution of the United States

Article II, Section 2, Clause 2

He shall have power to nominate and appoint, with the advice and consent of the Senate, Ambassadors, Ministers, Consuls, Judges of the Supreme Court, and such other Officers as may be necessary for the Executive branch of the Government.

He shall have power to grant Reprieves and Pardons for Offenses against the United States, except in Cases of Impeachment.

1. He shall have the sole Power to grant Pardons and Reprieves for Offenses against the United States, except in Cases of Impeachment.
