AN ACT REQUIRING CONTRACTS FOR CONSULTING SERVICES TO BE AWARDED BY COMPETITIVE BIDDING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any special or General
- 2 Law to the contrary, every contract awarded by a public
- 3 agency for consulting services, the estimated cost of which
- 4 exceeds ten thousand dollars, shall be awarded to the lowest
- 5 responsible and eligible bidder in accordance with procedures
- 6 set forth in sections forty-four A to forty-four H, inclusive,
- 7 of chapter 149 of the General Laws.
