SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

**Chap. 915.** AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NORFOLK COUNTY TO MAKE A STUDY RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF REGIONAL SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AND COLLECTION DISTRICTS WITHIN SAID COUNTY.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The county commissioners of Norfolk county are hereby authorized to make a feasibility study regarding the establishment of regional solid waste disposal collection and disposal districts to serve any two or more municipalities within Norfolk county.

Said study shall include a determination of the availability of any federal loans or grants; an inventory of the present solid waste handling and disposal practices of all the municipalities within Norfolk county; the development of the concept of two regional solid waste districts; the development of a solid waste management system for Norfolk county; and recommendations of logical groupings of municipalities which would be benefitted by joining such districts.

SECTION 2. For the purposes authorized by section one, the treasurer of said county, with the approval of the county commissioners, may expend such sums, not exceeding two hundred thousand dollars, as may be appropriated therefor.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

**Chap. 916.** AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN ADDITIONAL COURT OFFICER IN THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF BROOKLINE.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

The first sentence of section 62 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 153 of the acts of 1971, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "Norfolk", in line 20, the words: —, in the municipal court of Brookline, — and by striking out, in lines 24 and 25, the words " , in the municipal court of Brookline".

**Chap. 917.** AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE JOB CLASSIFICATION AND RETIREMENT BENEFITS OF RICHARD J. SHEA, A FORMER EMPLOYEE OF THE REGISTRY OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

In order to promote the public good and to correct an existing inequity, Richard J. Shea, a former employee of the registry of motor vehicles, shall, notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, be deemed to have held the position of chief motor vehicle review super-
