Serra relative to the tidelands lying within the city of Boston bordering on or near the waters of the Commonwealth; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 4385) of Salvatore F. DiMasi relative to extending the time concerning controls over certain tidelands along the Atlantic Avenue and Commercial Street waterfront in the city of Boston; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 4904) of Michael F. Flaherty relative to title to tidelands lying within the city of Boston and bordering on or near the waters of the Commonwealth; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 5083) of the Boston Redevelopment Authority and Thomas J. Valley relative to extending the time concerning controls over certain tidelands along the Atlantic Avenue and Commercial Street waterfront in the city of Boston, reports recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 6425) ought to be adopted.

*Ordered,* That the Committee on Natural Resources and Agriculture be authorized to sit during the recess of the General Court for the purpose of making an investigation and study of the subject matter of current House documents numbered 3224, relative to extending the time concerning the controls over certain tidelands along Atlantic Avenue and Commercial Street waterfront in the city of Boston; 3225, relative to title to tideland lying within the city of Boston and bordering on or near the waters of the Commonwealth; 4385, relative to extending the time concerning the controls over certain tidelands along Atlantic Avenue and Commercial Street waterfront in the city of Boston; 4904, relative to title to tidelands lying within the city of Boston and bordering on or near the waters of the Commonwealth; 5083, relative to extending the time concerning the controls over certain tidelands along Atlantic Avenue and Commercial Street waterfront in the city of Boston.

Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the state house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may require by summons the attendance and testimony of witnesses, may travel within and without the commonwealth and may expend for expert, legal, clerical and other services and for expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

Said committee shall report to the general court from time to time the results of its investigation and study and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into effect by filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or before the first Wednesday of December nineteen hundred and eighty-two.
