AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Walpole to make a Water
Loan.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Walpole is hereby
2 authorized to issue bonds to an amount not ex-
3 ceeding twenty thousand dollars, the same to be
4 payable four thousand dollars in the year nineteen
5 hundred and twenty-one, four thousand dollars in
6 the year nineteen hundred and twenty-two, four
7 thousand dollars in the year nineteen hundred
8 and twenty-three, four thousand dollars in the
9 year nineteen hundred and twenty-four, four
10 thousand dollars in the year nineteen hundred
11 and twenty-five, and said bonds are to be issued,
12 except as provided herein, in the manner and for
13 the purposes set forth in chapter two hundred and
14 seventy-seven of the acts of the year eighteen

15 hundred and ninety-three, and the proceeds there-
16 of may be used to retire bonds already issued or
17 pledged as authorized by said chapter. This issue
18 is to be considered as part of the amount of one
19 hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars, author-
20 ized by section five of said chapter two hundred
21 and seventy-seven.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
