AN ACT RELATIVE TO RECREATION PROGRAMS FOR PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED CHILDREN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 69 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by adding the following new section after section 29B:—
3 *Section 29C.* In any case where a city or town
4 establishes recreation programs for physically handi-
5 capped children and such programs have been approved
6 by the department of education, the department of edu-
7 cation shall reimburse said city or town by paying to it
8 one half of the cost thereof, including transportation of
9 such children to and from the site of such program on
10 each day it is held.
