The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Two.

An Act providing for the Retirement of Certain Sheriffs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter thirty-two of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section ninety, under the
3 heading Pensions for Sheriffs, the following new sec-
4 tion: —

5 *Section 90A.* A sheriff of a county who, having
6 attained the age of seventy and having completed
7 four successive terms as sheriff, shall be retired at
8 one half the regular rate of compensation paid to
9 him at the time of his retirement, and payable from
10 the treasury of the county in which he has served as
11 aforesaid.
