The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Six.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF MONEY-RAISING PROJECTS FOR CHARITABLE PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 271 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting after section 22A the following:—
- 3 *Section 22B.* Any veteran's organization duly or-
- 4 ganized and chartered by the congress of the United
- 5 States may conduct and operate projects designed to
- 6 raise money for charitable purposes, or operate games to
- 7 raise money where admission is charged, or charges made
- 8 for participation, in which prizes are offered which are
- 9 greater in value than the price of admission or greater
- 10 than the charge made for participation.
- 11 Application for the conduct of such games, or such
- 12 projects, may be approved by the mayor of any city or
- 13 the selectmen of any town. Fee for such application
- 14 and permits may be established by the mayor with the
- 15 approval of the city council or board of aldermen, or by
- 16 the board of selectmen of any town.
