Bill accompanying the petition of Earl C. Jacobs, city solicitor, for an amendment of the charter of the city of Lynn relative to the compensation of the mayor. Cities. January 15.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty.

AN ACT

To amend the Charter of the City of Lynn relative to the Salary of the Mayor.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter three hundred and forty of the
2 Special Acts of nineteen hundred and seventeen is hereby
3 amended by striking out the first sentence of section
4 seventeen and inserting in place thereof the following:—
5 *Section 17.* The mayor shall receive in full compensa-
6 tion for all services to the city a salary of five thousand
7 dollars per year, — so that the same shall read as fol-
8 lows:— *Section 17.* The mayor shall receive in full
9 compensation for all services to the city a salary of five
10 thousand dollars per year. The council may, by yea and
11 nay vote, establish a salary for its members, not exceeding
12 five hundred dollars a year, which shall not be increased
13 or diminished, to take effect during the current municipal
14 year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect June first, nine-
2 teen hundred and twenty.
