AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE LICENSING BOARD FOR THE CITY OF NEW BEDFORD TO ISSUE A LICENSE FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO BE EXERCISED ONLY ON THE PREMISES OF THE NEW BEDFORD AIRPORT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any limitation on the number
2 of licenses which may be issued in the city of New Bedford
3 under the provisions of section twelve of chapter one hundred
4 and thirty-eight of the General Laws, but subject, however,
5 to all other provisions of said chapter, the licensing board of
6 said city may issue a license under section twelve of said
7 chapter one hundred and thirty-eight for the sale of all
8 alcoholic beverages to be exercised only on that part of the
9 airport under the control of the New Bedford airport commis-
10 sion which is located in the city of New Bedford.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 the city council of the city of New Bedford with the approval
3 of its mayor and its airport commission.
