AN ACT AMENDING CHAPTER 216 OF THE ACTS OF 1976 RELATIVE TO THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF A CIVIC CENTER IN THE CITY OF WORCESTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8(a) of Chapter 216 of the Acts of 1976
2 is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence thereof, and
3 inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — “Section 8(a)
4 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to
5 the contrary, the commission is hereby authorized to maintain and
6 operate a civic center or to lease to any person corporate or
7 otherwise, upon such terms and in such manner as it deems
8 advisable, the operation of the civic center or any of the facilities
9 thereof, provided such lease shall not exceed a term of thirty years
10 and shall be subject to the limitations and procedures established
11 by section twenty-nine of chapter forty-three of the General
12 Laws.”

1 SECTION 2. Section 9(a) of Chapter 216 of the Acts of 1976,
2 as amended by Chapter 680 of the Acts of 1977, is hereby further
3 amended by deleting the words “seven million nine hundred
4 thousand” in the first sentence thereof and inserting in lieu thereof
5 the words “nineteen million nine hundred thousand”.
