AN ACT PROVIDING THAT, IN MAKING INITIAL APPOINTMENTS, CERTAIN QUALIFICATIONS OF COMMUNITY SERVICE CENTER DIRECTORS MAY BE WAIVED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 658 of the acts of 1967 is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 84A the following section:—
- 3 *Section 84A¹/₂.* In making the initial appointments of
- 4 center directors of community service centers under the
- 5 provisions of section five of chapter eighteen of the General
- 6 Laws, inserted by section one of this act, the commissioner of
- 7 public welfare may, with the approval of the state advisory
- 8 board in the department of public welfare, waive the qualifi-
- 9 cations for said offices required by the fifth paragraph of said
- 10 section five.
