Bill accompanying the petition of Joseph W. Crowell for legislation relative to insurance against loss by reason of damage caused to or by automobiles through their use or maintenance. Insurance. January 27.

AN ACT

Relative to Insurance against Loss by Reason of Damage caused to or by Automobiles through their Use or Maintenance.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Clause five of section thirty-two of chap-
2 ter five hundred and seventy-six of the year nineteen
3 hundred and seven as amended by chapter two hundred
4 and forty-eight of the acts of the year nineteen hundred
5 and eight is hereby amended by inserting in the fourth
6 line thereof, after the word " person ", the words : — or
7 against loss by reason of damage caused to or by auto-
8 mobiles through their use or maintenance, — so that the

9 clause shall read as follows :— Fifth, to insure any per-
10 son against bodily injury or death by accident, or any
11 person, firm or corporation against loss or damage on
12 account of the bodily injury or death by accident of any
13 person, or against loss by reason of damage caused to or
14 by automobiles through their use or maintenance, or
15 against damage caused by automobiles to property of
16 another, for which loss or damage said person, firm or
17 corporation is responsible, and to make insurance upon
18 the health of individuals.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
