In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-eight.

RESOLVE

To provide for Completing the Survey and Setting Monuments on the Boundary Line between the State of Rhode Island and the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

1 *Resolved*, That the commissioners on the topographical
2 survey and map of Massachusetts are hereby authorized
3 and directed, acting with any officer or agent who may
4 be authorized or appointed for a like purpose by the
5 state of Rhode Island, to complete the survey, and to
6 locate, define and mark by appropriate monuments the
7 boundary line between the state of Rhode Island and the
8 Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and are authorized to
9 expend in carrying out this work a sum not exceeding
10 fifteen hundred dollars, the same to be in addition to the
11 amount authorized by chapter eighty-eight of the resolves
12 of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-seven.
