AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT RIGHTS OF CHARLES GOUCHER, A FORMER EMPLOYEE OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of general
2 or special law to the contrary, the commonwealth may reinstate
3 Charles Goucher for the sole purpose of retirement. Said Charles
4 Goucher shall thereupon become eligible to membership in the
5 state retirement system upon his application. Upon said rein-
6 statement, the commonwealth may retire said Charles Goucher
7 for disability caused by injuries sustained or hazards undergone
8 in the actual performance of his duties as an employee of the
9 adjutant general's department. Said retirement shall be under
10 the provisions of section seven of chapter thirty-two of the Gen-
11 eral Laws in effect on the date of his original retirement.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
