AN ACT

To provide for the Removal of the Remains of the Dead from the Old Graveyard, situated in the Town of South Hadley, and for Other Purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The selectmen of the town of
2 South Hadley, in the county of Hampshire, are
3 hereby authorized, at the expense of the Ever-
4 green Cemetery Association, and in accordance
5 with the vote of said town at a meeting thereof
6 held on the twenty-third day of June in the year
7 eighteen hundred and eighty-eight, to move all
8 human remains from the old graveyard near the
9 centre of the town, laid out by the proprietors
10 of Hadley on the twenty-sixth day of March, in
11 the year seventeen hundred and twenty-eight, as
12 a burial-place, to the Evergreen Cemetery Asso-

13 ciation grounds in said South Hadley, to be
14 decently re-interred therein in lots to be provided
15 by said association; and said town is authorized
16 to alienate and convey the land from which said
17 remains are removed according to the vote of
18 said town at said meeting. Said town is author-
19 ized to remove the human remains from the re-
20 mainder of said old graveyard, and to alienate
21 and convey the same when the town shall so
22 vote.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
