

To accompany the petition of Maurice A. Donahue for legislation relative to the status of Michael Suchenicz as a member of the fire department of the city of Holyoke. Civil Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE STATUS OF FRANK MICHAEL SUCHENICZ AS A MEMBER OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF HOLYOKE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Frank Michael Suchenicz, who served
2 as a military substitute in the fire department of the
3 city of Holyoke, after having been wounded in action
4 on Guadalcanal, from February, nineteen hundred
5 and forty-four to March nineteen hundred and forty-
6 six, and who was awarded the Walter Scott Medal of
7 Honor for valor in the performance of duty, shall be
8 deemed to be permanently appointed to the position
9 of fireman in said fire department without examination
10 and without being required to serve any probationary
11 period; provided, that he submits proof, satisfactory
12 to the director of civil service, that such injury does
13 not incapacitate him for the performance of the duties
14 of fireman in said fire department.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
