AN ACT

Providing for the Compensation of Members of the
Legislature.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Each member of the senate and
2 house of representatives shall receive eight hun-
3 dred and fifty dollars for the regular annual ses-
4 sion for which he is elected, and one dollar for
5 every five miles travel from his place of abode,
6 once in each session, to the place of the sitting of
7 the general court, and the president of the senate
8 and the speaker of the house shall receive double

9 the compensation provided for members, except
10 for travel.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
