AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE FEES CHARGED BY NOTARIES PUBLIC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 262 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
- 2 out section 41, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, and
- 3 inserting in place thereof the following section: —
- 4 *Section 41.* The fees of notaries public shall not exceed fifty
- 5 cents per document notarized.
