AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF PITTSFIELD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 26 of chapter 280 of the acts of 1932, as  
2 most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 401 of the acts of  
3 1983, is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 6, the  
4 words “a commissioner of public health,”.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 26 of said chapter 280, as most  
2 recently amended by said section 1 of said chapter 401, is hereby  
3 further amended by striking out, in lines 10 and 14, the word  
4 “commissioner of public health” and inserting in place thereof, in  
5 each instance, the following word:— commissioner.

1 SECTION 3. Said section 26 of said chapter 280, as most  
2 recently amended by said section 1 of said chapter 401, is hereby  
3 further amended by striking out the fifth paragraph.

1 SECTION 4. The city of Pittsfield may establish, by ordinance,  
2 a board of health consisting of 5 members, 1 of whom shall be a  
3 physician.

1 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
