AN ACT AMENDING THE HORACE MANN TEACHERS PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1G of Chapter 15 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended in paragraph 34
3 by striking out the third sentence and inserting in place thereof
4 the following sentence: —

5 In order to provide financial incentives for qualified teachers
6 and to encourage the improved utilization of teaching resources
7 by school committees, the board, subject to appropriation, shall
8 award grants of up to two thousand five hundred dollars per
9 teacher, for teachers who shall undertake such expanded
10 responsibilities, provided, however, that the total dollar amount
11 of grants to a school district in any fiscal year shall be no higher
12 than two thousand five hundred dollars multiplied by ten percent
13 of the teachers within the district.
