AN ACT TO REGULATE AND CONTROL INSURANCE COMPANIES
WRITING AND ISSUING AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE COVERAGE
WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Any insurance company writing and issu-
2 ing policies for automobile insurance coverage within the
3 commonwealth of Massachusetts is forbidden, itself,
4 agents or servants or underwriters, to communicate with
5 other insurance companies, their agents, servants or
6 underwriters except on the question of accident records
7 about any applicant for insurance.

1 SECTION 2. Any such communication that prevents
2 an applicant from securing insurance shall constitute a
3 conspiracy, by the company, its agents and servants or
4 underwriters.
