

By Mr. Moore of Uxbridge, petition of Richard T. Moore for certain changes in the law relative to the Blackstone River and Canal Heritage State Park. Natural Resources and Agriculture.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Two.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BLACKSTONE RIVER AND CANAL HERITAGE STATE PARK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 From funds made available pursuant to item 2120-8844 of
2 section 2B of Chapter seven hundred and twenty-three of the Acts
3 of nineteen hundred and eighty-three, and item 2120-8881 of
4 section two of Chapter five hundred and sixty-four of the acts of
5 nineteen hundred and eighty-seven, the Department of
6 Environmental Management is hereby authorized to transfer to
7 the government land bank monies for the cost of acquisition,
8 disposition, and development of property in connection with the
9 establishment of the Blackstone River and Canal Heritage State
10 Park, and for associated costs of said bank related thereto, and
11 said bank is hereby authorized to receive such funds and apply
12 the same to such costs. The provisions of Chapter two hundred
13 and twelve of the Acts of nineteen hundred and seventy-five shall
14 govern the authority of said bank to act in respect of any such
15 property. Should the Department choose to transfer any monies
16 pursuant to this section, said Department and said bank shall
17 enter into an agreement relative to the use of said funds, in a
18 manner consistent with the establishment and maintenance of the
19 Blackstone River and Canal Heritage State Park. A copy of the
20 agreement shall be filed with the Blackstone River and Canal
21 Commission, the House of Representatives Ways and Means
22 Committee, and the Massachusetts Senate Ways and Means
23 Committee. Bonds authorized in said Chapter seven hundred and

24 twenty-three for purposes of said item 2120-8844, and in said
 25 Chapter five hundred and sixty-four for purposes of said item
 26 2120-8881 may be issued to finance the transfer of funds as
 27 aforesaid.
