AN ACT REQUIRING DRIVER SCHOOL MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAILERS TO COMPLY WITH SPECIFIC STANDARDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 32G of chapter 90 of the General Laws as appearing in
2 chapter 770 of the acts of nineteen hundred and seventy-one, is
3 hereby amended by adding the following sentences: —

4 Every motor vehicle or semi-trailer unit used exclusively in or
5 upon any private area and which is operated by a student driver
6 shall comply with standards for safety, performance and equip-
7 ment in conjunction with the requirements of General Laws,
8 chapter 90, section 7.

9 Such vehicles shall be available for inspection by the Registrar
10 of Motor Vehicles or his representative during reasonable
11 business hours.

12 This act shall take effect upon its passage.
