AN ACT REQUIRING COMPLETE WRITTEN REPORTS OF ELEVATOR INSPECTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 64 of chapter 143 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting in
3 place thereof the following two sentences: — Within ten days
4 after the inspection, said inspector shall file a complete writ-
5 ten report of all changes and defects in apparatus or equip-
6 ment to the commissioner of public safety upon forms to be
7 furnished by him. This requirement for the making of in-
8 spection reports shall not apply to the city of Boston.
