AN ACT

Relative to the Board of Street Commissioners of the City
of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

§1 SECTION 1. The board of street commissioners of the
2 city of Boston is hereby increased by adding thereto the
3 city engineer, the corporation counsel and the superin-
4 tendent of streets of said city, ex officiis; and in case of
5 a tie vote in said board, the mayor of said city may vote
6 as a member thereof, for the purpose of breaking such
7 tie. No members of said board shall hereafter be elected,
8 but the membership of said board shall be decreased as
9 the respective terms of the present members thereof shall
10 expire, or as they severally die or resign, so that at the
11 expiration of the term of the member of said board last
12 elected, at latest, said board shall consist only of the
13 three above-named officers of said city, ex officiis.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
