AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF CLASSIFICATIONS UNDER THE COMPULSORY MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY INSURANCE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 113B of chapter 175 of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 251 of 1951, is
3 hereby further amended by adding at the end the following
4 paragraphs: —

5 The commissioner in his classification of risks and deter-
6 mination of premium charges shall place in the schedule of
7 premium charges under class one any person under the age
8 of twenty-five years who for a period of three full years has
9 not been involved in an accident in which he has been deter-
10 mined to be at fault, and the parent of any person in whose
11 household there is such an operator under the age of twenty-
12 five years shall be included in this classification.

13 The question of responsibility for an accident in which a
14 person under the age of twenty-five years is involved shall be
15 determined by the registrar of motor vehicles in accordance
16 with the provisions of chapter ninety A.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January first, nine-
2 teen hundred and sixty-two.
