

Substituted by the House, on motion of Mr. Downey of Brockton, for a Bill authorizing the city of Lynn to pay an annuity to the widow of John F. Smith. March 26.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

An Act authorizing the City of Lynn to pay an Annuity to or for the Benefit of the Widow and Children of John F. Smith.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Lynn may pay an annuity
2 under the provisions of section eighty-nine of chapter
3 thirty-two of the General Laws, as most recently
4 amended by chapter three hundred and forty-three
5 of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-four, to or
6 for the benefit of the widow or for the benefit of the
7 children of John F. Smith, who died on August ninth,
8 nineteen hundred and thirty-four, from injuries re-
9 ceived while in the performance of duty as a member
10 of its police department, to the same extent as if the
11 injuries causing the death of said Smith had been re-
12 ceived after January first, nineteen hundred and thirty.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance during the current year by vote of the city
3 council, subject to the provisions of its charter.
