AN ACT TO PROHIBIT ELECTED MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS
FROM JOINING CITY OR TOWN RETIREMENT SYSTEMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter thirty-
2 two of the General Laws or of any special law estab-
3 lishing or relating to any contributory retirement
4 system no person holding office by popular election
5 may, after the effective date of this act, become a
6 member of a retirement system of any city or town.
