AN ACT

Relative to the Correction of Errors in the Ratio of Assessments upon Cities and Towns within the Metropolitan Park District.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. If by any error or omission that
2 may have been made by any city or town or of
3 its officers or agents, the commissioners to deter-
4 mine the proportion in which each of the cities
5 and towns within the metropolitan park district
6 shall contribute to meet the expenses required
7 under chapter four hundred and seven of the acts

8 of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-three,
9 the ratio of assessment upon any city or town
10 within said district for the first five years has
11 been thereby rendered excessive, the commission
12 appointed to make such assessment for the
13 second period of five years shall have the right
14 to and shall take into consideration such errors
15 and omissions and may reduce the second assess-
16 ment to be made by them to the extent and for
17 the amount that was occasioned by said error or
18 omission in the first assessment.

1 SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsis-
2 tent herewith are hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
