

Chap. 1030. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT OF PREVAILING WAGES AND FOR PAYMENT PROTECTION IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN PROJECTS FINANCED BY LOANS MADE BY THE MASSACHUSETTS HOUSING FINANCE AGENCY.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Paragraph (a) of section 5 of chapter 708 of the acts of 1966, as amended by section 3 of chapter 855 of the acts of 1970, is hereby further amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:—On all construction loans for the construction of eleven or more dwelling units the MHFA shall require (1) the payment of prevailing wages as determined by the commissioner of labor and industries as provided in sections twenty-six to twenty-seven D of chapter one hundred and forty-nine of the General Laws, and said commissioner shall enforce the provisions of said sections, and (2) a bond furnished by the sponsor or an equivalent escrow arrangement with the sponsor and supervised by the MHFA to assure payment out of the construction loan funds for all labor and materials for which claimants would have been able to claim a mechanic's lien if the claimants had complied with the provisions of chapter two hundred and fifty-four.

Chap. 1031. AN ACT REMOVING THE LIMITATION ON THE NUMBER OF PERSONS WHO MAY BE ELECTED AS TRUSTEES OF BOSTON COLLEGE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Section 1 of chapter 123 of the acts of 1863 is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 18 to 20, inclusive, the words “: *provided, nevertheless*, that the number of members shall never be greater than ten”.

Chap. 1032. AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE CONTROL OF AIR POLLUTION FROM MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The first sentence of section 7A of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 136 of the acts of 1971, is hereby further amended by inserting after the word “blocks”, in line 10, the words:—, pollution control systems or devices, rules and regulations providing for the periodic inspection of all motor vehicles and for the purpose of determining whether they are in compliance with motor vehicle air pollution control regulations which are adopted under the provisions of chapter one hundred and eleven and which are consistent with applicable federal laws.

SECTION 2. Section 16 of said chapter 90 is hereby amended by striking out the fifth sentence, as amended by chapter 11 of the acts of 1968, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:—No person operating a motor vehicle shall sound a bell, horn or other device, nor in any manner operate such motor vehicle so as to make
