Bill accompanying the petition of Ernest J. Titcomb for legislation relative to the powers of the Cherry Valley and Rochdale Water District. Water Supply. January 19.

AN ACT

Relative to the Powers of the Cherry Valley and Rochdale Water District.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section seven of chapter three hundred and eighty-one
2 of the acts of nineteen hundred and ten is hereby amended
3 to read as follows: — Said district may make such con-
4 tracts with individuals, corporations and the town of
5 Leicester for supplying water as may be agreed upon, and
6 may extend its pipes for that purpose, subject to the
7 direction of the selectmen of the town of Leicester,
8 through the highways of said town lying outside the
9 corporate limits of said district; and may extend its pipes
10 into the town of Oxford for a distance not exceeding four
11 thousand feet from the boundary line between the towns
12 of Leicester and Oxford, subject to the direction of the
13 selectmen of the town of Oxford.
