AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF CERTAIN LAND TO
KENNETH H. DUNHAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The commonwealth of Massachusetts, through its
2 department of public works, may sell and convey,
3 upon such terms and conditions as it may deem ex-
4 pedient, to Kenneth H. Dunham of Provincetown in
5 the county of Barnstable, a certain parcel of land in
6 said Provincetown bounded by a line:

7 Beginning at a point on the westerly boundary of
8 Race Point road three hundred feet north of the
9 northerly boundary of New Beach road and running
10 three hundred feet to the south along said westerly
11 boundary to the northerly boundary of New Beach
12 road; thence turning and running one thousand feet
13 to the west along the northerly boundary of New
14 Beach road; thence turning and running three hun-
15 dred feet to the north parallel to the westerly bound-
16 ary of Race Point road; thence turning and running
17 one thousand feet to the east to the point of begin-
18 ning. Containing in all, three hundred thousand
19 square feet, more or less.
