By Mrs. Gray of Framingham, petition of Barbara E. Gray that provision be made for the appointment of designees to county advisory boards. Counties.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Seven.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF DESIGNEES TO COUNTY ADVISORY BOARDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 28B of chapter 35 of the General Laws as appearing in
2 chapter 1166 of the acts of 1973, is hereby amended by striking
3 out the first 2 sentences and inserting in place thereof:—

4 “In every county other than Suffolk and Nantucket, there shall
5 be an advisory board to the County Commissioners consisting of
6 the city manager in the case of a plan D or plan E city or his
7 designee, or the mayor of each other city, or his designee, or the
8 chairman of the board of selectmen of each town, or his designee,
9 and the town manager or administrator in a town which does not
10 have selectmen, or his designee.

11 Every city and town shall indicate yearly in writing to the
12 secretary of said board and County Commissioners the name of
designee to said board.”
