RESOLUTIONS MEMORIALIZING CONGRESS IN FAVOR OF THE BORAH-O'MAHANAY LABOR BILL, SO CALLED.

1 *Resolved*, That the General Court of Massachusetts
2 hereby urges the Congress of the United States to
3 enact into law the provisions of the Borah-O'Mahaney
4 labor bill, so called; and be it further

5 *Resolved*, That copies of these resolutions be sent
6 forthwith to the secretary of the commonwealth, to the
7 president of the United States, to the presiding officers
8 of each branch of Congress and to the members
9 thereof from this commonwealth.
