Bill accompanying the petition of Edward E. McGrath for legislation to prohibit charges for the use or maintenance of gas meters. Public Lighting. January 1.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Charges for Gas and Gas Meters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or
2 corporation selling gas to charge the consumer for placing
3 or maintaining a gas meter on the premises of the con-
4 sumer or to make any charge except for gas actually con-
5 sumed.

1 SECTION 2. Violation of any provision of this act shall
2 be punished by a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars
3 for each offence.
