To accompany the petition of Melvin G. Rogers and others, county commissioners, that the county of Middlesex be authorized to provide additional accommodations for the registry of probate at the registry of deeds and probate building in Cambridge. Counties.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL ACCOMMODATIONS FOR THE REGISTRY OF PROBATE AT THE REGISTRY OF DEEDS AND PROBATE BUILDING AT CAMBRIDGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of providing adequate
2 accommodations for the registry of probate at the
3 registry of deeds and probate building at Cambridge
4 in the county of Middlesex, the county commission-
5 ers of said county may make additions to the probate
6 wing of said building, and furnish and equip said addi-
7 tions, and do all things incidental thereto.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes aforesaid, the county
2 treasurer of said county, with the approval of the
3 county commissioners, may borrow from time to time,
4 on the credit of the county, such sums as may be
5 necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, three hun-
6 dred thousand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes

7 of the county therefor, which shall bear on their face
8 the words, Middlesex County Registry of Deeds and
9 Probate Building Improvement Loan, Act of 1946.
10 Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan,
11 and such loans shall be payable in not more than ten
12 years from their dates. Such bonds or notes shall be
13 signed by the treasurer of the county and counter-
14 signed by a majority of the county commissioners.
15 The county may sell the said securities at public or
16 private sale upon such terms and conditions as the
17 county commissioners may deem proper, but not for
18 less than their par value. Indebtedness incurred un-
19 der this act shall, except as herein provided, be sub-
20 ject to chapter thirty-five of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 acceptance by the county commissioners of the county
3 of Middlesex; provided, that such acceptance occurs
4 during the current year.
