

By Mr. Flaherty of Boston, petition of Michael F. Flaherty for legislation to establish a new salary schedule for justices of the Commonwealth. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Six.

AN ACT PROVIDING A NEW SALARY SCHEDULE FOR JUSTICES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 22 of chapter 211 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out the first sentence, as most recently
3 amended by section 4 of chapter 339 of the acts of 1984, and
4 inserting in place thereof the following sentence: —

5 The chief justice of the court shall receive a salary of eighty-eight
6 thousand four hundred and five dollars, and each associate justice
7 a salary of eighty-five thousand three hundred and thirty dollars;
8 and the chief justice and associate justices shall annually receive
9 from the commonwealth upon the certificate of the chief justice,
10 the amount of expenses incurred by them in the discharge of their
11 duties.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 22 of said chapter 211 is hereby
2 further amended by striking out the first sentence, as most recently
3 amended by section 1 of this act, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following sentence: —

5 The chief justice of the court shall receive a salary of ninety-three
6 thousand seven hundred and ten dollars and each associate justice
7 a salary of ninety thousand four hundred and fifty dollars, and the
8 chief justice and each associate justice shall annually receive from
9 the commonwealth upon certificate of the chief justice, the amount
10 of expenses incurred by them in the discharge of their duties.

1 SECTION 3. Said section 22 of said chapter 211 is hereby
2 further amended by striking out the first sentence, as most recently
3 amended by section 2, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 sentence: —

5 The chief justice of the court shall receive a salary of ninety-nine
6 thousand three hundred and thirty dollars, and each associate
7 justice a salary of ninety-five thousand eight hundred and seventy-
8 seven dollars; and the chief justice and each associate justice, the
9 amount of expenses incurred by them in the discharge of their
10 duties.

1 SECTION 4. Section 2 of chapter 211A of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out the first sentence, as most recently
3 amended by section 8 of said chapter 339, and inserting in place
4 thereof the following sentence: —

5 The chief justice shall receive a salary of eighty-two thousand
6 and forty-four dollars and each associate justice a salary of
7 seventy-eight thousand nine hundred and seventy dollars; and the
8 chief justice and each associate justice shall annually receive from
9 the commonwealth, upon the certificate of the chief justice, the
10 amount of expenses incurred by them in the discharge of their
11 duties.

1 SECTION 5. Said section 2 of said chapter 211A is hereby
2 amended by striking out the first sentence, as most recently
3 amended by section 4, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 sentence: —

5 The chief justice shall receive a salary of eighty-six thousand
6 nine hundred and sixty-five dollars and each associate justice a
7 salary of eighty-three thousand seven hundred and ten dollars; and
8 the chief justice and each associate justice shall annually receive
9 from the commonwealth upon the certificate of the chief justice the
10 amount of expenses incurred by them in the discharge of their
11 duties.

1 SECTION 6. Said section 2 of said chapter 211A is hereby
2 amended by striking out the first sentence, as most recently
3 amended by section 5, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 sentence: —

5 The chief justice shall receive a salary of ninety-two thousand
6 one hundred and eighty-five dollars, and each associate justice a
7 salary of eighty-eight thousand seven hundred and thirty dollars;
8 and the chief justice and each associate justice shall annually
9 receive from the commonwealth upon the certificate of the chief
10 justice the amount of expenses incurred by them in the discharge of
11 their duties.

1 SECTION 7. Section 4 of chapter 211B, as most recently
2 amended by section 12 of said chapter 339, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out the first three paragraphs and inserting in
4 place thereof the following three paragraphs: —

5 The salaries of the justices of the trial court shall be paid by the
6 commonwealth. Each associate justice shall receive as a salary
7 seventy-five thousand eight hundred and ten dollars.

8 The administrative justice for the several departments shall
9 receive as a salary seventy-eight thousand nine hundred seventy
10 dollars.

11 The chief administrative justice shall receive as a salary eighty-
12 two thousand and forty-five dollars.

1 SECTION 8. Said section 4 of said chapter 211B is hereby
2 further amended by striking out the first three paragraphs, as most
3 recently amended by section 7, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following three paragraphs: —

5 The salaries of the justices of the trial court shall be paid by the
6 commonwealth. Each associate justice shall receive as a salary
7 eighty thousand three hundred and sixty dollars.

8 The administrative justice for the several departments shall
9 receive as a salary eighty-three thousand seven hundred and ten
10 dollars.

11 The chief administrative justice shall receive as a salary eighty-
12 six thousand nine hundred and sixty-five dollars.

1 SECTION 9. Said section 4 of said chapter 211B is hereby
2 amended by striking out the first three paragraphs, as most
3 recently amended by section 8, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following three paragraphs: —

5 The salaries of the justices of the trial court shall be paid by the
6 commonwealth. Each associate justice shall receive as a salary
7 eighty-five thousand one hundred and eighty dollars.

8 The administrative justice of the several departments shall
9 receive as a salary eighty-eight thousand seven hundred and thirty
10 dollars.

11 The chief administrative justice shall receive as a salary ninety-
12 two thousand one hundred and eighty-five dollars.

1 SECTION 10. Sections one, four, and seven of this act shall
2 take effect as of January first, nineteen hundred and eighty-seven.

1 SECTION 11. Sections two, five, and eight of this act shall take
2 effect as of January first, nineteen hundred and eighty-eight.

1 SECTION 12. Sections three, six, and nine of this act shall take
2 effect as of January first nineteen hundred and eighty-nine.
