AN ACT TO FACILITATE THE RECEIPT OF FEDERAL ASSISTANCE TOWARD HOME OWNERSHIP BY CERTAIN LOWER INCOME PERSONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 20 of chapter 18, as inserted by section
2 12 of chapter 885 of the acts of 1969, is hereby amended by
3 striking out the second sentence and substituting thereof the
4 following:—The department shall have a lien on the property
5 so purchased to the extent of assistance granted toward the
6 purchase of such home, except with regard to property pur-
7 chased with the further aid of any state or federal assistance,
8 subsidy, or guarantee in addition to that provided by the de-
9 partment of public welfare.

1 SECTION 2. Section 20 of chapter 18 is hereby further

3 sentence:—A two- or three-family dwelling in which the recip-
4 ient resides or plans to reside after purchasing, shall not be
5 considered income producing property within the meaning of
