AN ACT TO ESTABLISH CERTAIN DEANSHIPS IN REGIONAL COMMUNITY COLLEGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 27 of chapter 15 of the General Laws is herewith
2 amended by adding the following paragraph: —

3 Each regional community college shall have a full-time pro-
4 fessionally trained and qualified dean of student personnel serv-
5 ices for the first four hundred students or major fraction thereof
6 and an additional professionally trained counselor for each suc-
7 ceeding three hundred students or major fraction thereof. Such
8 personnel shall be employed on a twelve-month basis and not be
9 counted in the student-faculty ratio used in budget determina-
10 tion.
