AN ACT TO IMPROVE THE ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 211 Section 3, as amended, is hereby revoked; and a new
2 Section 3 of Chapter 211 shall be inserted in place thereof as
3 follows:

4 General superintendence of all courts of the Commonwealth
5 heretofore exercised by the Supreme Judicial Court shall be exer-
6 cised by a committee of judges consisting of two (2) judges from
7 each trial court department and from each of the appellate courts,
8 all to be elected from and by the members thereof to serve for three
9 (3) years. No member shall serve more than one (1) consecutive
10 term.
